7th Annual LPTSAC Chili Cook-Off Official Rules

Eligibility

1. The entrant must be a PTA member of a unit in good standing. Being a parent/guardian of a student is unnecessary. Aunts, uncles, grandpas, etc. and family friends are welcome as long as they're a PTA member. LPS students are not permitted to enter for themselves.
2. The entrant must complete the application before January 14, 2023, including the \$10 entry fee.
3. The entrant must represent ONLY one PTA. If the entrant is a member at more than one school, they must choose which school they are representing for the event.
4. The entrant must be present no later than 10:30 a.m. on the day of the event with precooked chili and a smokeless warming device (i.e.crockpot) and an extension cord. NO cooking can occur at the event space.
5. A name for your chili will be needed for judging purposes.

Prizes

1. The school represented by the 1st Place Chili will receive a \$500 grant to the school they are representing. The grant is courtesy of The Livonia Kiwanis Early Risers.
2. The 1st Place winner will receive a prize to be unveiled at the event.
3. Other prizes may or may not be offered (dependent upon number of participants) including People's Choice, Hottest Chili, and Best-Dressed Table.

Judging

1. Three judges will taste each chili and score based on the official rubric (1-10 in the categories of Look, Smell, Taste, and Heat).
2. Highest score (aggregate total of all three judges scores) will win.
3. Ties will be settled by Livonia PTSA Council back-up judges.
4. In the event of a "double tie" or no remaining chili to judge on, the prize will be awarded to the first entrant to register (sign-in) the morning of the event.

People's Choice Award

1. Upon entry, each guest of the event will receive 3 tickets to place in the bucket of their favorite chilis.
2. The entrant with the most tickets as of 2:00pm will be considered "The People's Champion".
